

# Dennison PTA General Meeting Minutes

Date: March 17th, 2016

**9:00am Call to Order:** Jenny Meade called the meeting to order at 9:01am. Anne Warren was present as secretary.

**9:00 - 9:00 Welcome and Introductions:** 17 members were present. ALL have a K student!

Library update for Goodnight Dennison - need tables for kids to be more orderly next year. About 200 people attended and 6 boxes of books were donated. Teachers donated 600 cookies! It occurred on a caucus night. Need new Chairs for next year.

**9:01 - 9:02 Approval of Minutes:** The January 21 minutes were reviewed by all attendees and approved by Brandi Sciacca.

**9:03 - 9:05 Treasurer's Report:** Crystal Frigo presented the report. She did an audit and came up negative, not where we thought we were, but there is money there. Ensuring checks written in fall are being cashed (or not). Working on budget for next year and want your input at next meeting on April 21. A workshop will occur at year end as we need to document the leader / budget / playbook per event. Recruiting additional parents and recruiting teachers (morning is a good time for 6th g) to attend meetings.

**9:06 - 9:16 Principal's Report:** Debbie Morrill presented the report. Piloted digital teacher librarian special as 4th rotation after 4/2015 approval. Helps us prepare our students for 21st C, with better focus on library and tech and 40 extra min of classroom instruction, Mrs. Yeoung has Master's in Tech. *The Tech special survey* respondents were students, parents, and teachers. The survey questions to each group were driven by school board requirements on efficacy.

The results: majority of students & parents responded positively all or most of the time to each question. Teachers responded over 80% on 100% scale to each question. The 4th special addition proved to be a good thing and so it is continuing next year.

*Make my voice heard survey* was anonymously taken on line by students and measured relationships 3.54, school/district climate 3.29, rigor and relevance 3.34. This is on a 4 point scale with midpoint at 2.5. Specific questions per category were enlightening on parental involvement, work on bullying, challenge, safety, & aspirations. Overall the scores are stable from previous year. It looks good for the students, teachers & parents. We have engaged learners, gaining life skills and preparing to be successful. As a result, the students will have more choices.

Destination Imagination (DI) 4 teams competed regionally and 2 are moving on. This is also in the Eagle Express today.

Publisher of math books for K-2 didn't have enough so we moved purchase priority from Open Court reading books to math. Following research and review at the school the math purchase is now in district final approval meeting on March 31.

District calendar 2016-17 is approved and different. **Dennison starts Tuesday August 16th.** On Thurs/Fri **May 18-19 no school due to state track meet.** Registration will again be online. New carpet installation is occurring.
